Referred to: **JOINT** RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 1 LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH 2 COMMISSION TO STUDY ISSUES RELATED TO VOCATIONAL TRAINING FOR 3 INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES. 4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring: 5 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study the following issues related to vocational training for individuals with intellectual disabilities: 6 7 Model programs within the North Carolina Community College System and (1) 8 The University of North Carolina System for training and developing 9 vocational expertise and job readiness in students with intellectual 10 disabilities. 11 (2) Enhancing employment outcomes for individuals with intellectual disabilities who are students of the North Carolina Community College 12 System or The University of North Carolina System. 13 Barriers to employment for individuals with intellectual disabilities and an 14 (3) examination of how the North Carolina Community College System and The 15 University of North Carolina System can reduce or eliminate those barriers. 16 17 (4) Establishment and expansion of partnerships between the North Carolina Community College System and community-based organizations that offer 18 job training and job placement opportunities for individuals with intellectual 19 disabilities, and between The University of North Carolina System and these 20 community-based organizations. 21 Adopting policies across North Carolina to prioritize employment for 22 (5) 23 individuals with intellectual and other disabilities, including, but not limited 24 to: 25 Policies for ensuring that students with intellectual disabilities are a. 26 prepared for higher educational opportunities upon completion of their elementary and secondary school education. 27 Policies for transition planning and job training for students with 28 b. 29 intellectual disabilities as they complete their elementary and 30 secondary school education. 31 **SECTION 2.** The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to 32 the 2013 General Assembly when it reconvenes in 2014 and shall make its final report to the 33 2015 General Assembly when it convenes. **SECTION 3.** This resolution is effective upon ratification. 34
