Short Title: Interstate Agreements to Improve Voter Rolls. (Public)

2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS TO ENTER INTO DATA
3 SHARING AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER STATES REGARDING INFORMATION ON
4 VOTING RECORDS AND VOTER REGISTRATION TO IMPROVE VOTER
5 REGISTRATION LIST MAINTENANCE.
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-82.14(a) reads as rewritten:
8 "(a) Uniform Program. – The State Board of Elections shall adopt a uniform program
9 that makes a reasonable effort:
10 (1) To remove the names of ineligible voters from the official lists of eligible
11 voters, and
12 (2) To update the addresses and other necessary data of persons who remain on
13 the official lists of eligible voters.
14 That program shall be nondiscriminatory and shall comply with the provisions of the Voting
15 Rights Act of 1965, as amended, and with the provisions of the National Voter Registration
16 Act. The State Board of Elections, in addition to the methods set forth in this section, may use
17 other methods toward the ends set forth in subdivisions (1) and (2) of this subsection, including
18 address-updating services provided by the Postal ~~Service.~~ Service, and entering into data
19 sharing agreements with other states to cross-check information on voter registration and voting
20 records. Each county board of elections shall conduct systematic efforts to remove names from
21 its list of registered voters in accordance with this section and with the program adopted by the
22 State Board. The county boards of elections shall complete their list maintenance mailing
23 program by April 15 of every odd-numbered year, unless the State Board of Elections approves
24 a different date for the county."
25 **SECTION 2.** The State Board of Elections shall actively seek ways to share and
26 cross-check information on voting records and voter registration with other states to improve
27 the accuracy of voter registration list, using resources such as the Electronic Registration
28 Information Center and by entering into interstate compacts for this purpose.
29 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
