Senator McLaurin

1 moves to amend the bill on page 21, line 20 through page 22, line 10, by rewriting those lines
2 to read:

3 **"§ 96-14.3. Duration of benefits.**

4 (a) Duration. – The total regular benefits paid to an individual may not be less than the
5 minimum total benefit and may not exceed the lesser of the maximum total benefit or the
6 individual's total benefit amount. The minimum total benefit for an individual is 13 times the
7 individual's weekly benefit amount. The maximum total benefit for an individual is 20 times
8 the individual's weekly benefit amount.

9 (b) Total Benefit Amount. – The total benefit amount for an individual is determined as
10 follows:

- 11 (1) Divide the individual's base-period wages by the average of the wages paid
- 12 to the individual in the last two completed quarters of the base period.
- 13 (2) Multiply the quotient by eight and two-thirds.
- 14 (3) Round the product to the nearest whole number.
- 15 (4) Multiply the resulting amount by the individual's weekly benefit amount as
- 16 determined under G.S. 96-14.2.";

18 And by renumbering the remaining sections of the Article accordingly.
