1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, lines 5-6, by deleting the following:

"(3) TO REJECT THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT'S OPTIONAL MEDICAID EXPANSION."

and substituting the following:

"(3) TO EXPAND MEDICAID UNDER THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT'S OPTIONAL MEDICAID EXPANSION FOR AS LONG AS FULL FEDERAL FUNDING IS AVAILABLE FOR THE EXPANSION POPULATION."; and

further amend the bill on page 2, lines 5-11, by deleting the following:

"SECTION 3. The State will not expand the State's Medicaid eligibility under the Medicaid expansion provided in the Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended, for which the enforcement was ruled unconstitutional by the U.S. Supreme Court in *National Federation of Independent Business, et al. v. Sebelius, Secretary of Health and Human Services, et al.*, 132 S. Ct. 2566 (2012). No department, agency, or institution of this State shall attempt to expand the Medicaid eligibility standards provided in S.L. 2011-145, as amended, or elsewhere in State law, unless directed to do so by the General Assembly."

and substituting the following:

"SECTION 3.(a) Effective January 1, 2014, and until full federal funding is no longer available for the expansion population, the eligibility standards for the State Medicaid program are expanded as provided in section 2001(a) of the Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148.

SECTION 3.(b) The Department of Health and Human Services shall promptly submit the appropriate State plan amendments or take other appropriate actions to effectuate the eligibility changes provided in subsection (a) of this section.

SECTION 3.(c) The Department of Health and Human Services shall report on its plan for the transition to new eligibility levels in 2014 to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Health and Human Services no later than October 1, 2013.".
