moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 5, by deleting the word "AND";

and on page 1, line 6, by deleting the word "EXPANSION." and substituting "EXPANSION,
AND (4) TO DETERMINE HOW TO MAKE N.C. HOSPITALS WHOLE FROM FEDERAL
FUNDING LOST BY NOT EXPANDING MEDICAID."; and

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on page 2, line 11, by inserting after that line the following new section:

9 "SECTION 4. It is the intent of the General Assembly to make North Carolina hospitals whole from the loss of federal funding as a result of not expanding Medicaid 10 eligibility, as provided in Section 3 of this act. There is hereby established the Committee on 11 Medicaid-Related Hospital Funding Loss for the purpose of (i) studying such loss of federal 12 funding and (ii) recommending to the General Assembly a methodology for managing the 13 shortfall to hospitals because of the State's failure to expand Medicaid eligibility. The 14 15 Committee shall consist of four members of the House of Representatives, to be appointed by the Speaker of the House, and four members of the Senate, to be appointed by the President Pro 16 Tempore of the Senate. The Committee shall make its recommendations to the General 17 18 Assembly no later than March 15, 2014, and shall expire upon the submission of its report."; 19 and

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21 by renumbering the remaining section accordingly.
