- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 5, by deleting the word "AND";
- 2
- 3 and on page 1, line 6, by deleting the word "EXPANSION." and substituting "EXPANSION,
- 4 AND (4) TO DETERMINE HOW TO MAKE N.C. HOSPITALS WHOLE FROM FEDERAL
- 5 FUNDING LOST BY NOT EXPANDING MEDICAID."; and
- 6
- 7 on page 2, line 11, by inserting after that line the following new section:
- 8
- 9 "SECTION 4. It is the intent of the General Assembly to make North Carolina
- 10 hospitals whole from the loss of federal funding as a result of not expanding Medicaid
- 11 eligibility, as provided in Section 3 of this act. There is hereby established the Committee on
- 12 Medicaid-Related Hospital Funding Loss for the purpose of (i) studying such loss of federal
- 13 funding and (ii) recommending to the General Assembly a methodology for managing the
- 14 shortfall to hospitals because of the State's failure to expand Medicaid eligibility. The
- 15 Committee shall consist of four members of the House of Representatives, to be appointed by
- 16 the Speaker of the House, and four members of the Senate, to be appointed by the President Pro
- 17 Tempore of the Senate. The Committee shall make its recommendations to the General
- 18 Assembly no later than March 15, 2014, and shall expire upon the submission of its report.";

- 21 by renumbering the remaining section accordingly.
