"(1c) "Career teacher" means a teacher who has obtained career status as provided in G.S. 115C-325(c).";

and on page 3, lines 48-51, by rewriting that line to read:

"(5) "Probationary teacher" means a licensed person, other than a superintendent, associate superintendent, or assistant superintendent, who has not obtained achieved career-teacher status and whose major responsibility is to teach or to supervise teaching.";
