1 moves to amend the bill on page 2, lines 40-42 by rewriting those lines to read:

2
3 "(c) Any voter who does not comply with subsection (a) of this section shall be
4 permitted to vote by one of following means:

5 (1) A provisional official ballot which shall be counted in accordance with
6 G.S. 163-182.1A.

7 (2) A provisional official ballot which shall be counted if the voter's
8 identification information can be verified by the county board prior to the
9 time set for the convening of the canvass pursuant to G.S. 163-182.5. The
10 voter's identification information shall be declared by the voter, under
11 penalty of a Class I felony in accordance with G.S. 163-275(13). For
12 purposes of this subdivision, "voter's identification information" shall mean
13 any of the following:

14 a. The number of the voter's North Carolina drivers license issued under
15 Article 2 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes, including a learner's
16 permit or a provisional license.

17 b. The number of the voter's special identification card for nonoperators
18 issued under G.S. 20-37.7.

19 c. The last four digits of the voter's social security number.

20 d. The voter's date of birth."
