The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 105-228.5(d)(3) reads as rewritten: "(d) Tax Rates; Disposition. —			
Additional Rate on Property Coverage Contracts. – An additional rate of seventy-four hundredths percent (0.74%) applies to gross on insurance contracts for property coverage.
