SECTION 1. G.S. 163-111 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:				
"(e1) Option for Voting Centers During Second Primary. – A county board of elections				
may, with approval of the State Board of Elections, provide for a limited number of voting sites				
to be opened during a potential second primary. The plan shall comply with all of the				
following:	_
