## Senator Barringer

1	moves to amend	the bill on page 9, lines 26-32 by deleting those lines and substituting the
2	following:	
3	"(6)	If the local board of education of the local school administrative unit in
4		which a charter school is located has adopted a policy requiring criminal
5		history checks under G.S. 115C-332, then the board of directors of each
6		charter school located in that local school administrative unit shall adopt a
7		policy mirroring the local board of education policy that requires an
8		applicant for employment to be checked for a criminal history, as defined in
9		G.S. 115C-332. Each charter school board of directors shall apply its policy
10		uniformly in requiring applicants for employment to be checked for a
11		criminal history before the applicant is given an unconditional job offer. A
12		charter school board of directors may employ an applicant conditionally
13		while the board is checking the person's criminal history and making a
14		decision based on the results of the check.".
