SECTION 2. To facilitate the implementation of this act, within 60 days of this act		
becoming effective and annually thereafter, the Department of Health and Human Services,		
Division of Public Health, shall provide to the Department of Public Instruction sample		
educational materials with the most current information available about the preventable causes		
of preterm birth, including induced abortion as a cause of preterm birth in subsequent		
pregnancies.		
SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with		
the 2013-2014 school year.
