Short Title: Campaign Finance Electronic Reporting. (Public) Sponsors: Referred to: April 15, 2013 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE ELECTRONIC FILING OF CERTAIN CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS BY CANDIDATE CAMPAIGN COMMITTEES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 163-278.9(j) reads as rewritten: "(j) Treasurers for each of the following entities shall electronically file each report required by this section that shows a cumulative total for the election cycle in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) the stated amount in contributions, in expenditures, or in loans, according to rules adopted by the State Board of Elections: A candidate for statewide office; office, if more than five thousand dollars (1) A State, district, county, or precinct executive committee of a political party, (2) if the committee makes contributions or independent expenditures in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) that affect contests for statewide office; office. A political committee that makes contributions in excess of five thousand (3) dollars (\$5,000) to candidates for statewide office or makes independent expenditures in excess of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) that affect contests for statewide office. (4) All other political committees, if more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). The State Board of Elections shall provide the software necessary to file an electronic report to a treasurer required to file an electronic report at no cost to the treasurer." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective January 1, 2014, and applies to reports

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
