Short Title: Revise Laws for Unoccupied School Buses. (Public)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MODIFY THE SPEED LIMIT FOR A SCHOOL BUS WITH NO CHILD PASSENGERS ON BOARD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-218(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Speed Limits. – It is unlawful to drive a school bus occupied by one or more child passengers over the highways or public vehicular areas of the State at a greater rate of speed than 45 miles per hour. It is unlawful to drive a school activity bus occupied by one or more child passengers over the highways or public vehicular areas of North Carolinathe State at a greater rate of speed than 55 miles per hour. A person shall drive a school bus or school activity bus with no child passengers on board over the highways or public vehicular areas of the State at a speed not greater than the posted speed limit, and the driver shall not be required to use hazard lights when traveling on the interstate."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
