1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT REQUIRING THAT THE STATE CONTROLLER, GOVERNMENT BUSINESS  
3 INTELLIGENCE COMPETENCY CENTER, ENHANCE THE STATE'S  
4 ENTERPRISE-LEVEL BUSINESS INTELLIGENCE THROUGH THE COLLECTION  
5 AND ANALYSIS OF DATA FROM VARIOUS STATE AGENCIES RELATED TO  
6 WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE AND CLAIMS FOR THE  
7 PURPOSE OF FRAUD PREVENTION AND DETECTION, AS RECOMMENDED BY  
8 THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON WORKERS' COMPENSATION  
9 INSURANCE COVERAGE COMPLIANCE AND FRAUD PREVENTION AND  
10 DETECTION.

11 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

12 **SECTION 1.** Section 6A.7A(g) of S.L. 2012-142 is amended by adding a new  
13 subdivision to read:

14 **"SECTION 6A.7A.(g)** Miscellaneous Provisions. –

15 ...

16 (3) Workers' compensation program integrity. – The State Controller and the  
17 GBICC shall enhance the State's business intelligence through the collection  
18 and analysis of data relating to workers' compensation claims for the purpose  
19 of preventing and detecting fraud, as follows:

20 a. The North Carolina Industrial Commission shall release to GBICC,  
21 or otherwise provide electronic access to, all data requested by  
22 GBICC relating to workers' compensation insurance coverage,  
23 claims, appeals, compliance, and enforcement under Chapter 97 of  
24 the General Statutes.

25 b. The North Carolina Rate Bureau (Bureau) shall release to GBICC, or  
26 otherwise provide electronic access to, all data requested by GBICC  
27 relating to workers' compensation insurance coverage under Chapter  
28 58 of the General Statutes. The Bureau shall be immune from civil  
29 liability for releasing information pursuant to this sub-subdivision,  
30 even if the information is erroneous, provided the Bureau acted in  
31 good faith and without malicious or willful intent to harm in  
32 releasing the information.

33 c. The Department of Commerce, Division of Employment Security  
34 (DES), shall release to GBICC, or otherwise provide access to, all  
35 data requested by GBICC relating to unemployment insurance



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- 1 coverage, claims, and business reporting under Chapter 96 of the  
2 General Statutes.
- 3 d. The Department of Labor shall release to GBICC, or otherwise  
4 provide access to, all data requested by GBICC relating to safety  
5 inspections, wage and hour complaints, and enforcement activities  
6 under Chapter 95 of the General Statutes.
- 7 e. The Department of Revenue shall release to GBICC, or otherwise  
8 provide access to, all data requested by GBICC relating to the  
9 registration and address information of active businesses, business  
10 tax reporting, and aggregate federal tax Form 1099 data for  
11 comparison with information from DES, the Rate Bureau, and the  
12 Department of the Secretary of State for the evaluation of business  
13 reporting. The Department of Revenue and the Office of the State  
14 Controller shall work jointly to assure that the evaluation of tax  
15 information pursuant to this subdivision is performed in accordance  
16 with applicable federal law.
- 17 f. All information shared with GBICC and the State Controller under  
18 this subdivision is protected from release and disclosure in the same  
19 manner as any other information available to GBICC and the State  
20 Controller pursuant to this section."

21 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
