Senator Nesbitt

1 moves to amend the bill on page 159, line 21, 2 by inserting a new section on the line to read:

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"EXPAND MEDICAID COVERAGE TO PERSONS FOR WHOM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WILL PAY ONE-HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE SERVICE COSTS UNDER THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT

SECTION 12H.10A.(a) Effective January 1, 2014, G.S. 108A-54.6(c), enacted by Section 12H.10 of this act, is amended by adding a new subdivision to read as follows:

'(7) All people under age 65 who have incomes equal to or less than one hundred thirty-three percent (133%) of the federal poverty guidelines.'

SECTION 12H.10A.(b) Section 3 of S.L. 2013-5 is repealed.

SECTION 12H.10A.(c) Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, from the savings generated as a result of expanding Medicaid eligibility to all people under age 65 who have incomes equal to or less than one hundred thirty-three percent (133%) of the federal poverty guidelines:

- (1) The sum of ten million three hundred sixty-three thousand one hundred seventy-six dollars (\$10,363,176) for the 2013-2014 fiscal year and the sum of fourteen million six hundred twenty-eight thousand seventeen dollars (\$14,628,017) for the 2014-2015 fiscal year is appropriated to the Division of Medical Assistance for the State's share of additional Medicaid contract costs for administrative expenses related to this expansion.
- (2) The balance of the savings generated as a result of this expansion in the sum of twelve million one hundred thirty-one thousand four hundred forty-three dollars (\$12,131,443) for the 2013-2014 fiscal year and in the sum of thirty million three hundred sixty-one thousand two hundred twenty-two dollars (\$30,361,222) for the 2014-2015 fiscal year is appropriated to the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services.

SECTION 12H.10A.(d) Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, as a result of the savings achieved by the expansion described in Section 12H.10A.(c):

(1) Funds appropriated in this act to the Department of Health and Human Services shall be reduced as follows:
