1 moves to amend the bill on Page 270, Lines 32 and 33, by rewriting the lines to read:
2 "of the Highway Patrol, (i) the State Bureau of Investigation,
3 (ii) the Department of Public Safety; or (iii) the constituent";
4 and

6 On Page 272, Line 33 through Page 273, Line 2, by deleting the lines; and

8 On Page 284, Line 19 through Page 305, Line 23, by deleting the lines; and

10 On Page 305, Line 24, by inserting immediately after the line a new bill section to read:

11 "NO TRANSFER OF SBI TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY

12 SECTION 17.7.(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, neither the
13 State Bureau of Investigation nor the Division of Criminal Information shall be transferred
14 from the Department of Justice and the funds appropriated in this act to the Department of
15 Justice for the State Bureau of Investigation shall be reduced by an additional two million
16 dollars (\$2,000,000) in the 2014-2015 fiscal year.

17 SECTION 17.7.(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the reduction
18 for DPS Law Enforcement Health Benefits shall be reduced by two million eighty-seven
19 thousand twenty-six dollars (\$2,087,026) in both fiscal years to reflect the fact that the State
20 Bureau of Investigation is not being transferred to the Department of Public Safety.

21 SECTION 17.7.(c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the funds
22 appropriated in this act to the Department of Justice shall be reduced by an additional two
23 million eighty-seven thousand twenty-six dollars (\$2,087,026) in both fiscal years. The
24 Department of Justice shall use the sum of two million eighty-seven thousand twenty-six
25 dollars (\$2,087,026) of funds available in the Separate Insurance Benefits Plan in both fiscal
26 years to pay employer health premiums and contributions for sworn law enforcement officers.";

29 On Page 396, Lines 4 through 18, by rewriting those lines to read:

30 "SECTION 35.17.(b) During the 2013-2015 fiscal biennium, the Department of
31 Public Safety and the Department of Justice shall report monthly to the State Health Plan for
32 Teachers and State Employees the total amount of employer premiums due on behalf of sworn



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1 law enforcement officers employed by each Department. The Plan shall reduce the total  
2 premiums the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Justice owe by this amount,  
3 and the Department of State Treasurer shall transfer the same amount from the Separate  
4 Insurance Benefit Plan established under G.S. 143-166.60 to the Plan.

5         **SECTION 35.17.(c)** For each fiscal year of the 2013-2015 fiscal biennium, the  
6 Department of State Treasurer shall calculate the total compensation for which the Department  
7 of Public Safety and the Department of Justice have paid retirement contributions on behalf of  
8 sworn law enforcement officers. The Department of State Treasurer shall multiply this total  
9 compensation by five and forty hundredths percent (5.40%) for months during the 2013-2014  
10 fiscal year and five and fifty-one hundredths percent (5.51%) for months during the 2014-2015  
11 fiscal year and shall transfer the resulting amount from the Separate Insurance Benefit Plan  
12 established under G.S. 143-166.60 to the Retiree Health Benefit Fund established under  
13 G.S. 135-7(f)."; and

15 Moves to adjust the appropriate totals accordingly.
