1 moves to amend the bill on page 15, line 48, by adding the following between lines 48 and 49:  
2 "SECTION 6.1.(a) Sections 1 through 6 of this act become effective only if  
3 approved by the qualified voters of the County of Wake in a referendum. The election shall be  
4 conducted by the Wake County Board of Elections on November 4, 2014. The question on the  
5 ballot shall be:  
6  FOR  AGAINST  
7 Changing the manner of election of the Wake County Board of Education beginning  
8 in 2016 to seven members elected from newly configured numbered single-member districts  
9 and two members elected from lettered single-member districts, the time for elections to  
10 November of even-numbered years, and the determination of the results by plurality.'  
11 SECTION 6.1(b). If a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the question,  
12 Sections 1 through 6 of this act become effective as provided therein. Otherwise, they do not  
13 become effective."
