"SECTION 5.1. Section 9 of Chapter 717 of the Session Laws of 1975, as amended by Chapter 952 of the Session Laws of 1983, S.L. 2011-138, and S.L. 2012-106 reads as rewritten:

17 'Sec. 9. The Wake County Board of Education, acting jointly and by a majority vote of all 18 members present, shall elect a chair to preside at meetings and a vice-chair to preside at meetings in the absence of the chair; and the chair and vice-chair shall have a vote on all 19 20 matters considered by the Wake County Board of Education. All-In the case of district seats, vacancies occurring in the membership of the Wake County Board of Education by reason of 21 death, resignation, removal of residence from the district from which elected, or for any cause 22 whatsoever, shall be filled by the remaining members of said board by appointing a member 23 24 from the voting district creating the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired term. In the 25 case of at-large seats, vacancies occurring in the membership of the Wake County Board of Education by reason of death, resignation, removal of residence from Wake County, or for any 26 27 cause whatsoever, shall be filled by the remaining members of said board by appointing a 28 member at-large for the remainder of the unexpired term. The Wake County Board of 29

Education shall have all power and authority as a Board of Education as herein conferred and as are conferred by the General Statutes of North Carolina on boards of education in general."
