1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 16 2 by rewriting that line to read: 3 "TO REQUIRE CERTAIN ESTABLISHMENTS TO POST A NOTICE IF FIREARMS ARE 4 ALLOWED ON THE PREMISES; TO PROVIDE THAT AN EMPLOYEE OF AN 5 INSTITUTION OF HIGHER"; 6

And on page 4, lines 16-17 by inserting between those lines the following:

"SECTION 3.(b) Article 53B of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

'§ 14-409.41. Firearms notice required in certain locations.

- A person who manages, operates, or controls any property to which the provisions of G.S. 14-269.3 are applicable shall conspicuously post signs clearly stating whether or not, and in what manner, firearms are allowed on the premises.
- (b) The sheriff of the county in which the property is located may take the following actions and may impose the following civil penalty on a person who manages, operates, or controls the property and fails to comply with the requirements of subsection (a) of this section:
 - First violation. Provide the person in violation with written notice of the (1) person's first violation and notification of action to be taken in the event of subsequent violations.
 - Second violation. Provide the person in violation with written notice of the (2) person's second violation and notification of civil penalties to be imposed for subsequent violations.
 - (3) <u>Subsequent violations. – Impose on the person in violation a civil penalty of</u> not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for the third and subsequent violations.

Each day on which a violation of this section occurs may be considered a separate and distinct violation."
