1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO MODIFY THE DUTIES OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON INDIAN  
3 EDUCATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-210.4 reads as rewritten:

6 "§ 115C-210.4. Duties of the Council.

7 It shall be the duty of the Advisory Council:

- 8 (1) ~~To advise the State Board of Education on ways to meet more effectively the~~  
9 ~~educational needs of Indian students;~~To review annually relevant data on  
10 American Indian students using reports made available to the Council by the  
11 Department of Public Instruction. The review shall include, but not be  
12 limited to, data on academic performance, growth, suspension and expulsion  
13 events, dropouts, and graduation rates.  
14 (2) To advocate for meaningful programs to reduce and eventually eliminate  
15 low achievement and concurrent high attrition rates among American Indian  
16 students;students.  
17 (2a) To prepare an annual report and make an annual presentation to the State  
18 Board of Education to advise the State Board on ways to meet the  
19 educational needs of American Indian students more effectively based on the  
20 State Board's strategies, policies, and information.  
21 (3) ~~To prepare an annual present and share the annual report on a fiscal year~~  
22 ~~basis on the status of Indian education, said report to be presented to the~~  
23 ~~State Board of Education and to~~with the various Indian tribal organizations  
24 at national conferences and the statewide Indian Unity  
25 Conference;Conference along with an action plan based on  
26 recommendations.  
27 (4) To work closely with ~~the Division of Indian Education in the Department of~~  
28 ~~Public Instruction-Instruction, Tribal Leaders, and Title VII Coordinators to~~  
29 ~~improve coordination and communication between and among~~  
30 ~~programs;programs.~~  
31 (4a) To improve consultations among the State Board of Education, the  
32 Department of Public Instruction, and American Indian tribal communities,  
33 students, parents, and educators.  
34 (5) To advise the State Board of Education on any other aspect of American  
35 Indian education when requested by the State Board to do so."

36 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
