1 moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 5, by rewriting the line to read:
2 "PREGNANCIES, AND TO PROVIDE SUCH INFORMATION TO CHARTER,
3 NONPUBLIC, AND HOME SCHOOL STUDENTS."; and

5 on page 2, lines 2-3, by adding between those lines the following new sections to read:

6 "**SECTION 1.1.** G.S. 115C-238.29F(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) Health and Safety Standards. – A charter school shall meet the same health and
8 safety requirements required of a local school administrative unit. The Department of Public
9 Instruction shall ensure that charter schools provide parents and guardians with information
10 about meningococcal meningitis and influenza and their vaccines at the beginning of every
11 school year. This information shall include the causes, symptoms, and how meningococcal
12 meningitis and influenza are spread and the places where parents and guardians may obtain
13 additional information and vaccinations for their children.

14 The Department of Public Instruction shall also ensure that charter schools provide parents
15 and guardians with information about cervical cancer, cervical dysplasia, human
16 papillomavirus, and the vaccines available to prevent these diseases. This information shall be
17 provided at the beginning of the school year to parents of children entering grades five
18 ~~through~~ 12. This information shall include the causes and symptoms of these diseases,
19 how they are transmitted, how they may be prevented by vaccination, including the benefits
20 and possible side effects of vaccination, and the places where parents and guardians may obtain
21 additional information and vaccinations for their children.

22 The Department of Public Instruction shall also ensure that charter schools provide students
23 in grades seven through 12 with information annually on the preventable causes of preterm
24 birth in subsequent pregnancies, including induced abortion, smoking, alcohol consumption,
25 the use of illicit drugs, and inadequate prenatal care.

26 The Department of Public Instruction shall also ensure that charter schools provide students
27 in grades nine through 12 with information annually on the manner in which a parent may
28 lawfully abandon a newborn baby with a responsible person, in accordance with G.S. 7B-500.

29 The Department of Public Instruction shall also ensure that the guidelines for individual
30 diabetes care plans adopted by the State Board of Education under G.S. 115C-12(31) are
31 implemented in charter schools in which students with diabetes are enrolled and that charter
32 schools otherwise comply with the provisions of G.S. 115C-375.3."
