1	(b) After referral of a complaint to the North Carolina Attorney General's Consumer
2	Protection Division, if the roofing contractor is adjudicated by a court to have violated any
3	provision under this Article or under Article 8 of Chapter 75 of the General Statutes, the Board
4	shall suspend, revoke, or deny the roofing contractor's license for such period of time as may be
5	ordered by the court, or in the event that the court orders the license suspended, revoked, or
6	denied without setting the term of the suspension, revocation, or denial, the period shall be six
7	months from the date the order is issued.
8	(c) The Board shall not renew, reinstate, or issue a new roofing contractor license to
9	any person subject to any term of denial, suspension, or revocation pursuant to this section until
10	the term has been completed and the person has made application and has paid the required fees
11	as provided for in this Article.
12	<u>87-15.33.</u> Criminal history record checks of applicants for license.
13	(a) All applicants for license shall consent to a criminal history record check, and no
14	license shall be issued to an applicant who refuses to consent to a criminal history record check.
15	The Board shall ensure that the State and national criminal history of an applicant is checked.
16	The Board shall be responsible for providing to the North Carolina Department of Justice the
17	fingerprints of the applicant to be checked, a form signed by the applicant consenting to the
18	criminal history record check and the use of fingerprints and other identifying information
19	required by the State or National Repositories, and any additional information required by the
20	Department of Justice. The Board shall keep all information obtained pursuant to this section
21	confidential. For purposes of this section, a "criminal history record check" is a report resulting
22	from a request made by the Board to the North Carolina Department of Justice for a history of
23	conviction of a crime, whether a misdemeanor or felony, that in the discretion of the Board
24	bears on an applicant's fitness for licensure as a roofing contractor.
25	(b) The cost of the criminal history record check and the fingerprinting shall be borne
26	by the applicant.
27	(c) If an applicant's criminal history record check reveals one or more criminal
28	convictions, the conviction shall not automatically bar licensure. The Board shall consider all
29	of the following factors regarding the conviction:
30	(1) The level of seriousness of the crime.
31	(2) The date of the crime.
32	(3) The age of the person at the time of the conviction.
33	(4) The circumstances surrounding the commission of the crime, if known.
34	(5) The nexus between the criminal conduct of the person and the job duties of
35	the position to be filled.
36	(6) The person's prison, jail, probation, parole, rehabilitation, and employment
37	records since the date the crime was committed.
38	If after reviewing the factors, the Board determines that any of the grounds set forth in the
39	subdivisions of G.S. 87-15.31 exist, the Board may deny licensure of the applicant. The Board
40	may disclose to the applicant information contained in the criminal history record check that is
41	relevant to the denial. The Board shall not provide a copy of the criminal history record check
42	to the applicant. The applicant shall have the right to appear before the Board to appeal the
43	Board's decision. However, an appearance before the full Board shall constitute an exhaustion
44	of administrative remedies in accordance with Chapter 150B of the General Statutes.
45	(d) The Board, its officers, and employees, acting in good faith and in compliance with
46 47	this section, shall be immune from civil liability for denying licensure to an applicant based on information provided in the applicant's criminal history record check.

Roofing Contractor License Revolving Fund. 19 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Board to be 20 designated the "North Carolina Roofing Contractor License Revolving Fund." The fund shall 21 be a continuing fund, shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of 22 application and renewal fees, late fees, administrative fees, reinstatement fees, and any other 23 monies collected pursuant to this Article. 15	history records, the Board shall provide to the Department of Justice the fingerprints of the
16	applicant, a form signed by the applicant consenting to the criminal history record check and
17	use of the fingerprints and other identifying information required by the Repositories, and any
18	additional information required by the Department. The fingerprints shall be forwarded to the
19	State Bureau of Investigation for a search of the State's criminal history record file, and the
20	State Bureau of Investigation shall forward a set of fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of
21	Investigation for a national criminal history record check. The Board shall keep all information
22	obtained pursuant to this section confidential. The Department of Justice may charge a fee to
23	offset the cost incurred by the Department of Justice to conduct a criminal history record check
24	under this section, but the fee shall not exceed the actual cost of locating, editing, researching,
25	
26	and retrieving the information." SECTION 4. Section 2 of this act becomes effective October 1, 2013. The

27 remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law.
