"SECTION 13. Sections 1 through 12 of this act become effective only if approved by a majority of voters of the County of Wake in a referendum. The election shall be conducted by the Wake County Board of Elections in the 2014 general election if the Wake County Board of Commissioners adopts a resolution requesting the referendum. The question on the ballot shall be:

FOR AGAINST

Allowing the Wake County Board of Commissioners to assume responsibility from the Wake County Board of Education for the construction, improvement, ownership, and acquisition of all public school real property.

SECTION 14. This act applies only to the County of Wake.

SECTION 15. If a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the question, Sections 1 through 12 of this act become effective January 1, 2015."
