3 "(6) A merchant, or retail or hardware store, when ~~it lawfully~~ the merchant or
4 store does not purport to be a locksmith and lawfully (i) rekeys a lock at the
5 time of sale of the lock, (ii) duplicates keys or installs, services, repairs,
6 rebuilds, reprograms, rekeys, or maintains locks in the normal course of its
7 business, a key, except for duplicating a transponder-type key that requires
8 programming, or (iii) installs as a service a lock on a door if both the door
9 and lock were purchased from the same so long as the merchant or store
10 does not represent itself as a locksmith merchant."
