Short Title: Agritourism Sign Location/DOT Standards. (Public)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT AGRICULTURAL TOURISM SIGNS ON STATE  
3 HIGHWAYS ARE SUBJECT TO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCATION  
4 AND PLACEMENT RULES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE  
5 TRANSPORTATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.  
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 106-22.5(a) reads as rewritten:  
8 "(a) The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services shall work with the  
9 Department of Transportation to provide directional signs on major highways at or in  
10 reasonable proximity to the nearest interchange ~~or within one mile~~ leading to an agricultural  
11 facility that promotes tourism by providing tours and on-site sales or samples of North Carolina  
12 agricultural products to area tourists. The Department shall follow the sign location and  
13 placement rules of the Department of Transportation's Tourist-Oriented Directional Signs and  
14 Logo Signs programs."  
15 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
