The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. The Department of Public Safety shall study the feasibility and cost-effectiveness of having State Highway Patrol uniforms be produced by Correction Enterprises. The Department of Public Safety shall report the results of this study to the Joint Legislative Oversight Committee on Justice and Public Safety by March 1, 2015.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2014.
