Yancey Right-of-Way Safety.

Sponsors: Representative Presnell. Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM OR BOW AND ARROW FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN YANCEY COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, or to attempt to discharge a firearm or bow and arrow, from, on, across, or over the roadway or right-of-way of any State-maintained road. **SECTION 2.** Violation of the provisions of this act is punishable as a Class 3 misdemeanor. **SECTION 3.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Yancey County.

SECTION 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 2014, and applies to offenses
