SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-133(a) reads as rewritten:

SECTION 2. The Governor shall appoint the additional district court judge for District 10 authorized by this act, and that judge's successor shall be elected in the 2014 election for a four-year term commencing January 1, 2015.

SECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of one hundred fifty-nine thousand three hundred ninety-four dollars (\$159,394) for the 2013-2014 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred fifty-nine thousand three hundred ninety-four dollars (\$159,394) for the 2014-2015 fiscal year to fund the additional district court judgeship authorized by this act.

SECTION 4. The Chief District Court Judge in District 10 should use the additional district court judge authorized by this act to address driving while impaired offenses in the District to the fullest extent possible.
