Short Title: Durham/Payments for On-Street Parking. (Local)

5 FACILITIES.
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 160A-301 reads as rewritten:
8 "**§ 160A-301. Parking.**
9 (a) On-Street Parking. – A city may by ordinance regulate, restrict, and prohibit the
10 parking of vehicles on the public streets, alleys, and bridges within the city. When parking is
11 permitted for a specified period of time at a particular location, a city may ~~install a parking~~
12 ~~meter at that location and~~ require any person parking a vehicle therein to ~~place the meter in~~
13 ~~operation~~ pay a fee for the entire time that the vehicle remains in that location, up to the
14 maximum time allowed for parking there. ~~Parking meters may be activated by coins or tokens.~~
15 The city may require that payment for vehicle parking be made by a means of payment
16 specified by the city, including coins, currency, tokens, credit cards, or electronic means.
17 Proceeds from the use of ~~parking meters or devices for parking on public streets~~ must be used
18 to defray the cost of ~~enforcing and administering traffic and parking ordinances and~~
19 ~~regulations operating the city's parking program or providing parking facilities.~~
20"
21 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to the City of Durham only.
22 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
