	the definition of the bill on page 29, lines 13 and 14, by adding between the lines:  (5) The economic impact of net metering on all customers, including an analysis of whether and to what extent customers using net metering systems are subsidized by other retail electric customers who do not employ net metering. The study shall examine the benefits and costs of net metering systems to North Carolina's electric distribution and transmission systems and the extent to which customers owning net metering systems contribute to the fixed costs of the State's electric public utilities."
