7 "Teaching (NCCAT) shall report the following information to the State Board of Education and
8 the Fiscal Research Division of the General Assembly no"; and

10 on page 27, lines 28-29, by deleting the language "and the Schools of Government and Law at
11 the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill" and substituting "the Department of Computer
12 Science at North Carolina State University, the Schools of Government and Law at the
13 University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and, in the discretion of the State CIO, schools and
14 departments at other public and private institutions of higher learning in the State."; and

16 on page 161, line 5, by deleting the quotation mark at the end of that line; and

18 on page 161, lines 5-6, by inserting between those lines a new subsection to read as follows:
19 "(h) Coordination with other entities. – The Advisory Board shall coordinate its efforts
20 under this Part with NORTH CAROLINA TRAVEL AND TOURISM COALITION, INC. and
21 with North Carolina Travel Industry Association, Inc."; and

23 on page 177, lines 25-48, by rewriting those lines to read:
24 "**EVALUATION OF ELECTRICAL DEVICES, APPLIANCES, AND EQUIPMENT**
25 **USED BY THE DIVISION OF ADULT CORRECTION**

26 **SECTION 16C.4. G.S. 66-25(b) reads as rewritten:**

27 '(b) Electrical devices, appliances, or equipment used by the Division of Adult
28 Correction of the Department of Public Safety ~~shall~~ may be evaluated for safety and suitability
29 by the Central Engineering Section of the Department of Public Safety. The evaluation shall be
30 conducted in accordance with nationally recognized standards.'"; and


