commissioners shall determine the amount of county revenues to be appropriated in the county budget ordinance to the local school administrative unit for the budget year. The board of

SECTION 3. On or before August 1, 2014, the Union County Board of		
Commissioners and the Union County Schools shall jointly establish a working group to		

develop a multiyear plan to address existing and ongoing capital needs of the Union County Schools. The working group shall consist of up to 14 people, half appointed by each board. The



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6 7 working group shall complete its work and report to the Union County Board of Commissioners and the Union County Schools on or before June 30, 2015.

SECTION 4. This act shall apply only in Union County.

SECTION 5. Section 1 of this act is effective when it becomes law and expires upon adoption of the budget ordinance by the Union County Board of Commissioners for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law and shall not affect any action filed prior to the effective date of this act.

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
