5 **"NO TRANSFER OF SBI TO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY**

6 **SECTION 17.1A.(a)** Notwithstanding anything in this act or in the N.C. House of
7 Representatives Appropriations Committee Report on the Continuation, Expansion, and Capital
8 Budgets for Senate Bill 744, dated June 11, 2014 to the contrary, the State Bureau of
9 Investigation shall not be transferred to the Department of Public Safety. Accordingly:

- 10 (1) There shall be no reductions to the Department of Justice or to the
- 11 Department of Public Safety, nor increases in the Department of Public
- 12 Safety, for any of the following:
- 13 a. State Bureau of Investigation Transfer
- 14 b. SBI Computer Crime Unit
- 15 c. ALE District Office Consolidation
- 16 (2) The Department of Justice shall use the sum of two hundred fifty-two
- 17 thousand five hundred ninety-six dollars (\$252,596) to increase the ability of
- 18 the SBI's Computer Crimes Unit to investigate reports of Internet crimes
- 19 against children by adding two sworn agents and one non-sworn intelligence
- 20 analyst to the Unit.
- 21 (3) The management flexibility reduction to the Department of Justice shall be
- 22 increased by an additional one million two hundred thirty-one thousand four
- 23 hundred thirty-nine dollars (\$1,231,439)."; and
