1 moves to amend the bill on page 56, lines 28-29, by inserting the following subsection between  
2 those lines:

4 "SECTION 9.7.(b1) G.S. 115C-325.3(e) reads as rewritten:  
5 "(e) Right to ~~Petition for Hearing.~~ —~~A teacher shall have the right to petition the local~~  
6 ~~board of education for a hearing no later than 10 days after receiving written notice. Within 10~~  
7 ~~days of receiving written notice of the superintendent's decision to recommend nonrenewal of~~  
8 ~~contract, a teacher shall have the right to file a written request with the local board of education~~  
9 ~~for a hearing. The local board may, in its discretion, shall grant a hearing request received in a~~  
10 ~~timely manner regarding the superintendent's recommendation for nonrenewal. The local board~~  
11 ~~of education shall notify the teacher making the petition of its decision whether to grant a~~  
12 ~~hearing. If the request for a hearing is granted, the~~The local board shall conduct a hearing  
13 pursuant to the provisions of G.S. 115C-45(c) and make a final decision on whether to offer the  
14 teacher a renewed contract. The board shall notify a teacher whose contract will not be renewed  
15 for the next school year of its decision by June 15; provided, however, if a teacher submits a  
16 request for a hearing, the board shall provide the nonrenewal notification within 10 days of the  
17 hearing or such later date upon the written consent of the superintendent and teacher. A  
18 decision not to offer a teacher a renewed contract shall not be arbitrary, capricious,  
19 discriminatory, for personal or political reasons, or on any basis prohibited by State or federal  
20 law."".
