12 **"PART IX. SPECIFICATIONS FOR USE OF COAL ASH COAL COMBUSTION**  
13 **PRODUCTS IN PUBLIC PROCUREMENT**

15 **SECTION 15.** Article 3 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by  
16 adding a new section to read:

17 **"§ 143-58.6. Specifications for Use of Coal Combustion Products.**

18 (a) State Construction Office to Develop Technical Specifications. – The State  
19 Construction Office shall develop recommended technical specifications for the use of coal  
20 combustion products that may be utilized in any construction by all State departments,  
21 institutions, agencies, community colleges, and local school administrative units, other than the  
22 Department of Transportation. The technical specifications shall address all products used in  
23 construction, including, but not limited to, the use of coal combustion products in concrete and  
24 cement products, and in construction fill.

25 (b) Department of Transportation to Develop Technical Specifications. – The  
26 Department of Transportation shall develop recommended technical specifications for the use  
27 of coal combustion products that may be utilized in any construction by the Department of  
28 Transportation. The technical specifications shall address all products used in construction,  
29 including, but not limited to, the use of coal combustion products in concrete and cement  
30 products, and in construction fill.

31 (c) Specification Factors. –The State Construction Office and the Department of  
32 Transportation shall consider safety, best practice engineering standards, quality, cost, and



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1 availability of an in-State source of coal combustion products in developing the recommended  
2 technical specifications pursuant to this section.

3 (d) Consultation. – The State Construction Office and the Department of Transportation  
4 shall consult with each other in the development of the recommended technical specifications  
5 pursuant to the provisions of this section, in order to insure that the recommended technical  
6 standards are uniform for similar types of construction.

7 (e) Report of Recommended Specifications.– The State Construction Office and the  
8 Department of Transportation shall report the recommended technical specifications developed  
9 pursuant to this section to the Environmental Review Commission and the Joint Legislative  
10 Transportation Oversight Committee on or before February 1, 2015. "";
