Low-risk impoundments shall be closed as soon as practicable, but no later "(3) than December 31, 2022. A proposed closure plan for such impoundments must be submitted as soon as practicable, but no later than December 31, 2018. Such impoundments shall be dewatered. The Department shall require such sites to comply with the closure and post-closure requirements established by Section .1627 of Subchapter B of Chapter 13 of Title 15A of the North Carolina Administrative Code. Specifically, the owner of an impoundment shall: (i) install and maintain a cap system; (ii) install and maintain a leachate collection system; (iii) install and maintain a groundwater monitoring system; (iv) establish financial assurance that will ensure that sufficient funds are available for closure pursuant to this subdivision, post-closure maintenance and monitoring, any corrective action that the Department may require, and to satisfy any potential liability for sudden and nonsudden accidental occurrences arising from the impoundment, and subsequent costs incurred by the Department in response to an incident, even if the owner becomes insolvent or ceases to reside, be incorporated, do business, or maintain assets in the State; and (v) conduct post-closure care for a period of 30 years, which period may be increased by the Department upon a determination that a longer period is necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare; the environment; and natural resources, or decreased upon a determination that a shorter period is sufficient to protect public health, safety, and welfare; the environment; and natural resources. The Department may require implementation of any other measure it deems necessary to protect public health, safety, and welfare; the environment; and natural resources, including imposition of institutional controls that are sufficient to protect public health, safety, and welfare; the environment; and natural resources. If, during the post-closure care period, groundwater monitoring at the impoundment shows contaminants to be present in groundwater in exceedance of groundwater quality standards
