SECT	ION 1. Section 1.1(d) of S.L. 2009-429 reads as rewritten:
"SECTION 1.	.1.(d) Distribution and Use of Tax Revenue. – The City of Jacksonville shall,
on a quarterly bas	sis, remit the net proceeds of the occupancy tax to the Jacksonville Tourism
Development Aut	hority. The Authority shall use at least two-thirds of the funds remitted to it
under this subsection for tourism-related expenditures and shall use the remainder to promote	
travel and touris	sm in Jacksonville and shall use the remainder for tourism-related
expenditures. Jacks	sonville."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2013, and expires July 1, 2023.
