1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO REMOVE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON SATELLITE ANNEXATIONS  
3 FOR THE TOWNS OF HOOKERTON AND MAYSVILLE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 160A-58.1(b)(5) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) A noncontiguous area proposed for annexation must meet all of the following  
7 standards:

8 ...

9 (5) The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when added to the  
10 area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not exceed ten percent  
11 (10%) of the area within the primary corporate limits of the annexing city.

12 This subdivision does not apply to the Cities of Belmont, Claremont,  
13 Concord, Conover, Durham, Elizabeth City, Gastonia, Greenville, Hickory,  
14 Kannapolis, Locust, Marion, Mount Airy, Mount Holly, New Bern, Newton,  
15 Oxford, Randleman, Roanoke Rapids, Rockingham, Sanford, Salisbury,  
16 Southport, Statesville, and Washington and the Towns of Ahoskie, Angier,  
17 Apex, Ayden, Benson, Bladenboro, Bridgeton, Burgaw, Calabash, Catawba,  
18 Clayton, Columbia, Columbus, Cramerton, Creswell, Dallas, Dobson, Four  
19 Oaks, Fuquay-Varina, Garner, Godwin, Granite Quarry, Green Level,  
20 Grimesland, Holly Ridge, Holly Springs, Hookerton, Huntersville,  
21 Jamestown, Kenansville, Kenly, Knightdale, Landis, Leland, Lillington,  
22 Louisburg, Maggie Valley, Maiden, Mayodan, Maysville, Middlesex,  
23 Midland, Mocksville, Morrisville, Mount Pleasant, Nashville, Oak Island,  
24 Ocean Isle Beach, Pembroke, Pine Level, Princeton, Ranlo, Richlands,  
25 Rolesville, Rutherfordton, Shallotte, Smithfield, Spencer, Stem, Stovall, Surf  
26 City, Swansboro, Taylorsville, Troutman, Troy, Wallace, Warsaw, Watha,  
27 Waynesville, Weldon, Wendell, Windsor, Yadkinville, and Zebulon."

28 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
