And on page 2, lines 19 through 21 by rewriting the lines to read:

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"**SECTION 8.5.** G.S. 115C-238.29F(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Employees. – Employees and Contracted Services. –

moves to amend the bill on page 1, line 3 by rewriting the line to read:

- (1) An employee of a charter school is not an employee of the local school administrative unit in which the charter school is located. The board of directors of a charter school may discharge teachers and nonlicensed employees.
 - <u>a.</u> <u>Teachers.</u>—The charter school's board of directors shall employ and contract with necessary teachers to perform the particular service for which they are employed in the school; at least fifty percent (50%) of these teachers shall hold teacher licenses. All teachers who are teaching in the core subject areas of mathematics, science, social studies, and language arts shall be college graduates.
 - <u>b.</u> <u>Non-licensed Employees. The board also may employ necessary employees who are not required to hold teacher licenses to perform duties other than teaching and may contract for other services. The board may discharge teachers and nonlicensed employees.</u>
 - c. Contracted Services. Any contract for personnel services entered into by a board of directors of a charter school shall require as a term of the contract the disclosure of personnel records of individuals hired pursuant to the contract. The disclosure of these personnel records shall be consistent with the disclosure requirements of Article 21A of this Chapter.
