6	The provisions of this Chapter do not apply to:

8	(6)	A merchant, or retail or hardware store, when the merchant or store does not	
9		purport to be a locksmith and lawfully (i) rekeys a lock at the time of sale of	
10		the lock, (ii) duplicates a key, except for duplicating a transponder type key	
11		that requires programming, or (iii) installs as a service a lock on a door if	
12		both the door and lock were purchased from the same merchant.store, so	
13		long as all of the following apply:	
14		a. It is lawfully duplicating keys or installing, servicing, repairing,	
15		rebuilding, reprograming, rekeying, or maintaining locks in the	
16		normal course of its business.	
17		b. It maintains a physical location in this State.	
18		c. It maintains a sales and use tax permit in accordance with	
19		<u>G.S. 105-164.16.</u>	
20		<u>d.</u> <u>It does not represent itself as a locksmith.</u>
