1 moves to amend the bill on page 19, lines 8-9, by adding the following new section between the

4 "SECTION 26.5.(a) G.S. 74F-16 reads as rewritten:

5 "§ 74F-16. Exemptions.

6 The provisions of this Chapter do not apply to:

7 ...
8 (6) A merchant, or retail or hardware store, ~~when the merchant or store does not~~
9 ~~purport to be a locksmith and lawfully (i) rekeys a lock at the time of sale of~~
10 ~~the lock, (ii) duplicates a key, except for duplicating a transponder type key~~
11 ~~that requires programming, or (iii) installs as a service a lock on a door if~~
12 ~~both the door and lock were purchased from the same merchant store, so~~
13 ~~long as all of the following apply:~~

- 14 a. It is lawfully duplicating keys or installing, servicing, repairing,
15 rebuilding, reprograming, rekeying, or maintaining locks in the
16 normal course of its business.
17 b. It maintains a physical location in this State.
18 c. It maintains a sales and use tax permit in accordance with
19 G.S. 105-164.16.
20 d. It does not represent itself as a locksmith.

22 SECTION 26.5.(b) If Senate Bill 734, 2013 Regular Session, becomes law,
23 Section 2.5 is repealed."
