For a taxpayer whose North Carolina taxable income is less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), anAn amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) of net business income the taxpayer receives during the taxable year. In the case of a married couple filing a joint return where both spouses receive or incur net business income, the maximum dollar amounts apply separately to each spouse's net business income, not to exceed a total of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000). For purposes of this subdivision, the term "business income" does not include income that is considered passive income under the Code.'
