moves to amend the bill on page 9, lines 43-44, by rewriting those lines to read:			
"SECTION 7.(a) Sections 1 through 5 of this act become effective only if approved by a majority of the qualified voters of the City of Greensboro in a referendum. The election shall be conducted by the Guilford County Board of Elections in the 2015 general election. The question on the ballot shall be: "[] FOR [] AGAINST Providing for changes to the form of government of the City of Greensboro including number of council members, districts, and mayor's duties." SECTION 7.(b) If a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the question, Sections 2 and 5 of this act becomes effective with respect to elections conducted in 2017 and thereafter and Section 1, 3, and 4 of this act become effective December 1, 2015. SECTION 8. This act is effective when it becomes law."
