Public school employees shall receive three days of paid leave for bereavement upon the death of an immediate family member. As used in this section, "immediate family member" refers to (i) the employee's spouse, child, parent, sibling, grandparent, and grandchild, and any of the corresponding step, half, or in-law relationships, or (ii) any person living within the employee's home for whom the employee may claim a deduction under section 151 of the Internal Revenue Code.

SECTION 2. Article 23 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is amended by

Employees shall not be permitted to accumulate bereavement leave or to use bereavement leave for creditable service toward retirement.

The State Board of Education shall adopt rules to implement the provisions of this section." **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
