SECTION 1. G.S. 136-202 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

the contrary, each Metropolitan Planning Organization shall only conduct studies for projects			
that the Metropolitan Planning Organization has funding available to begin work on or			
complete."			
SECTION 2. G.S. 136-212 reads as rewritten:
