	Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 14-269.2(g) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
" <u>(</u>	8) A person registered under Chapter 74C of the General Statutes as an arme	
	security guard when acting in the discharge of the guard's duties and with the	
	permission of the college, university, or superintendent of the local school	
	administrative unit. At the request of any local law enforcement agency, the	
	college, university, or superintendent of the local school administrative uni	
	as appropriate, shall provide to the agency a list of the armed security guard	
	employed by the college, university, or local board of education, and sha	
	update the list as needed. No person who satisfies the criteria of this	
	subdivision is guilty of a criminal violation of this section because the	
	person's name is not included in the list provided to the local law	
	enforcement agency."	
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2015.
