Short Title: Standard of Proof/Public Safety Dispatchers. (Public) Sponsors: Representative Torbett. Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ALTER THE STANDARD OF PROOF FOR PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS AND DISPATCHERS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 99E of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read: "Article 7. "Liability for Public Safety Telecommunicators and Dispatchers. "§ 99E-56. Standard of proof. Any persons acting within the capacity of a 911 or public safety telecommunicator or dispatcher at a public safety answering point who is sued in a civil action arising from the performance of any lawful and prescribed actions pertaining to the person's assigned job duties shall be entitled to a standard of clear and convincing evidence in a court of law. For purposes of this Article, "public safety answering point" (PSAP) shall be defined as in G.S. 62-40." **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to any cause of
