2 AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE USE OF DEALER PLATES ON DEALERSHIP LOANER
3 VEHICLES.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-79(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) Restrictions on Use. – A dealer license plate may be displayed only on a motor
7 vehicle that meets all of the following requirements:

- 8 (1) Is part of the inventory of the dealer.
- 9 (2) Is not consigned to the dealer.
- 10 (3) Is covered by liability insurance that meets the requirements of Article 9A of
11 this Chapter.
- 12 (4) Is not used by the dealer in another business in which the dealer is engaged.
- 13 (5) Is driven on a highway by a person who meets one of the following
14 descriptions:
 - 15 a. Has a demonstration permit to test-drive the motor vehicle and
16 carries the demonstration permit while driving the motor vehicle.
 - 17 b. Is an officer or sales representative of the dealer and is driving the
18 vehicle for a business purpose of the dealer.
 - 19 c. Is an employee of the dealer and is driving the vehicle in the course
20 of employment.
 - 21 d. Is an employee of the dealer or of a contractor of the dealer and is
22 driving the vehicle within a 20-mile radius of a place where the
23 vehicle is being repaired or otherwise prepared for sale.
 - 24 e. Is an employee of the dealer or of a contractor of the dealer and is
25 transporting the vehicle to or from a vehicle auction or to the dealer's
26 established salesroom.
 - 27 f. Is an officer, sales representative, or other employee of a franchised
28 motor vehicle dealer or is an immediate family member of an officer,
29 sales representative, or other employee of a franchised motor vehicle
30 dealer.
 - 31 g. Is a customer whose vehicle is being serviced or repaired by a dealer,
32 provided that the motor vehicle displaying the dealer plate is
33 provided to the customer by the dealer at no charge and only for the
34 duration of the servicing or repair of the customer's vehicle."

35 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
