the purchase price to the buyer if the buyer cancels the purchase before midnight of the third

 business day after the date the buyer signed the purchase agreement or if any of the material terms of the purchase agreement are changed by the dealer. To make the cancellation effective, the buyer shall give the dealer written notice of the buyer's cancellation of the purchase. The dealer shall return the <u>initial</u> deposit or other payment toward or payment for the purchase price to the buyer within seven business days, or 15 business days when payment is by personal check, after receipt of the notice of cancellation or within three business days of any change by the dealer of the purchase agreement. For purposes of this section, "business day" means any day except Sunday and legal holidays. Each time the dealer gives the buyer a new set of financing terms, unless the financing terms are more favorable to the buyer, the buyer shall be given another three-day cancellation period. The dealer shall not commence setup procedures until after the final three-day cancellation period has expired.

- (e) If the buyer cancels the purchase after the three-day cancellation period, but before the sale is completed, and if:
 - (1) The manufactured home is in the dealer's inventory, the dealer may retain from the <u>initial</u> deposit or other payment received from the buyer actual damages up to a maximum of ten percent (10%) of the purchase price; or
 - (2) The manufactured home is specially ordered from the manufacturer for the buyer, the dealer may retain actual damages up to the full amount of the buyer's <u>initial</u> deposit or other payment received from the buyer.
